Checks - Be Aware of Who They Are From

Check fraud is one of the more common scams that MY CREDIT UNION and other financial institutions are seeing. Unfortunately, these fraudsters have talent for taking real information and creating bad checks. They then hope our members and staff don't ask questions about it. MYCU staff are being regularly trained to potentially identify fraud before it can impact our members, but with new scams constantly popping up, we need your help to stay ahead of the fraudsters.

In 2023, the Federal Trade Commission listed check fraud as one of the top scams in the United States. U.S. consumers lost over \$96 million due to check fraud. It's up to our members to help fight fraud too! If you received a mysterious check in the mail with little or no instruction of what to do with it, it's more than likely a scam. If you're ever questioning why you've received a check from a friend, family member or business you're not expecting, contact the sender through a trusted channel. Never trust the contact info that accompanies the check you have received.

Please remember that these fraudsters can make things look real! Regardless of the story behind the check: MY CREDIT UNION (and all financial institutions) reserve the right to place any third-party check on hold for a reasonable period of time. When a check is brought into any MY CREDIT UNION branch, it is a piece of paper that neither MYCU nor you, our member, have been paid for yet. A hold protects not only you when making the deposit, but it also protects MY CREDIT UNION and all your fellow 24,000+ members.



One last thing: Make sure you are letting staff know if any of the following applies to you:

- If you're not expecting a check or if you mysteriously receive a check in the mail, UPS® or FedEx®.
- Someone has asked you to cash a check for them and provide them with some of the funds while you keep the rest.
- If anyone has advised you to withhold information or deceive staff about a check. Fraudsters do not want you to be truthful with staff members, as they would be able to identify a scam.
