9th Anniversary of Sponsorship

The simple act of placing a flag at a veteran's headstone for Memorial Day. For many of these 200,000 veterans, we are the only visitors to their headstone each year – to thank them for their service and to acknowledge that their sacrifice is not forgotten! Special recognition to Nicole Amor from White Bear Lake, who recently died in service to her country and was laid to rest at Fort Snelling National Cemetery.

In addition to preparing and storing all 200,000 flags – MY CREDIT UNION members and staff also place the flags in sections M & Y. A very special moment for all involved. Thank you to all MY CREDIT UNION members who continue to support Flags for Fort Snelling! Even if you aren't able to place flags (they always need volunteers to remove the flags, too), members are encouraged to visit the cemetery Memorial Day week. To stand and look at all 200,000 flags saluting our service members simultaneously is powerful.

Coin Flip!

Members may have noticed the increased frequency of the coin counting machine at the Lyndale office being "Out of Service." Most of the time, the culprit is members not sifting the "junk" out of their coins before depositing them into the coin tray. This includes nails, bolts, washers, paper clips to a wide variety of other random objects. Not only does this impact other members being able to use the machine themselves, but creates a fairly significant service charge each month to have a technician come out to remove items jammed into the machine. The service company also warns these events will shorten the life expectancy of the machine itself. So, as a courtesy, especially "frequent flyer" coin machine users, members are asked to be mindful of policing their coins for miscellaneous debris BEFORE depositing their coins. We will be monitoring this issue a little bit more closely moving forward...

More Ways to Be Cyber Secure

1. Create **strong passwords**. At least 10-12 characters long. Include upper & lowercase letters, digits, and special characters.
2. Use a **password manager** to create complex passwords without needing to remember them.
3. **Don't use the same password** for multiple accounts.
4. Don't open emails from **unknown senders**.
5. Never email **financial information** or your **SSN**.
6. Download software and email attachments only from **sources you know that are trustworthy**.
7. **Read all disclosure information** before downloading software, including apps.
8. Avoid clicking links; instead, **type authenticated web addresses** directly into your browser bar.
9. **Limit what you share** on social networking sites.
10. Don't stay signed into accounts. **Log off when finished**.
11. Close all pop-up windows. Consider **using a pop-up blocker**.
12. Don't put **unknown flash drives** into your computer.
13. Use **multifactor authentication** for online accounts when available.
