What is PMI, & why do some home loans require it?

If you're in the market for a new home, PMI is probably a term you've heard from your real estate agent or loan originator. PMI stands for 'private mortgage insurance', and it is designed to protect lenders if a house falls into foreclosure.

What that means for you: PMI allows you to buy a home without putting 20% down. The premium, a percentage of your original loan amount, is usually added in to your monthly mortgage payment. While that does increase your borrowing costs, it allows you to buy a home much sooner than waiting to build up a big nest egg.

You will find MY CREDIT UNION to have lower PMI premiums than for-profit banks, and in some cases they can be tax-deductible (consult your tax advisor about your specific situation). PMI will be automatically suspended as your principal payments accrue.

Did you know...

Though we are now called MY CREDIT UNION, the initial credit union established on March 27, 1957, was called the Richfield School Employees Credit Union, with the field of membership including all employees of Independent School District (ISD) #280.

From November 19, 1957, to the mid-60s, the credit union manager was Delroy Gochnauer. During this time, credit union records were carried back and forth from his home to the school in a shoe box. The credit union "office" was in the manager's home on Wentworth Ave., where office hours were from 3 to 5 p.m. on Mondays only. Loans were made and dispersed at the office, while deposits and loan payments were made to the shoe box and recorded on handwritten ledgers later.
